



APA starts the distribution of private copying compensation for the year 2024

APA – Audiovisual Producers Association, as an entity entrusted by the Italian Society of Authors and Publishers (SIAE) pursuant to Articles 71-sexties et seq. of the Law of 22 April 1941, No. 633, starts, on 29 September 2025 the distribution of compensation for private copying, accrued by audiovisual works of the television sector in the year 2024. The distribution of the compensation is carried out in accordance with the provisions of the “*Regulation for the distribution of private video copying compensation*”, approved by the Assembly of APA by resolution of 8 June 2023, which can be consulted in this section, under **New Regulation Private Copying** (<https://www.apaonline.it/en/private-copy/>).

In the same section, under **Work list**, is available the list of audiovisual works that, as of now, are eligible for allocation for the relevant year (<https://www.apaonline.it/en/private-copy/private-copying-compensation-year-2022-and-following/>).

The list is not exhaustive and the Association reserves to admit additional audiovisual works to the distribution, also upon documented request of the rightholders.

The rightholders, i.e., the original producers and their successors in title, may request the payment of the accrued compensation, including through collective management organizations or independent management entities, by submitting a specific application to the APA in accordance with the provisions of Article 2.3 of the “*Regulation for the distribution of private video copying compensation*”.

On February 11, 2025, the General Board of APA verified the Expense Reimbursement adequacy, pursuant to Article 4.1 of the Regulations for the distribution of private video copying compensation, and resolved to increase the amount by 1%, based on the costs actually incurred for the distribution of the last year CCPs, and those expected to be incurred in the current year. The expense reimbursement is therefore quantified as 14% (fourteen percent) of the CCPs distributed.

Furthermore, on July 18, 2025, the General Board of APA – in compliance with Article 2.8 of the “Regulations for the Distribution of Private Video Copy Compensation” – approved the release of the provisions in the amount of 5%, for the accrual year 2023.

At the same assembly, the General Board also approved a temporary prudential provision relating to the accrual year 2024, on the CCPs collected, in the amount of 5%.
